Official of the Year Selection Criteria

Rules Knowledge – The nominee, has demonstrated a thorough knowledge of the rules, not only in test scores, but in on the field application. The nominee applies the Rules in accordance with OAOA philosophy.

Mechanic Knowledge – The nominee, has demonstrated a thorough knowledge, and application, of the Mechanics and Philosophies, Guidelines, and Interpretations, as provided by the OAOA Mechanics Manual.

Appearance – The nominee wears the Uniform in accordance with the guidelines provided in the OAOA Mechanics manual. Exuding a Professional appearance.

Professionalism – The nominee, carry's he/she with confidence, and handles him/herself in a professional manner, on and off the field. When dealing with Coaches and players, the nominee maintains a calm and professional approach.

Mentorship – The nominee understands the philosophies and Interpretations of the OAOA, and the Association, and is a positive influence for other officials to apply those philosophies without bias.
